Earlier we gave out admissions for 10 children a year but due to change in government rules and regulation we offered admission for 20 kids but eventually we ended up admitting 23 kids. The new students have enrolled in (number of students and classes they enrolled in) except for play group and nursery. Among them are some students who were in different schools before joining us. As usual we announced vacancy for appointing 3 new teachers and therefore received several applications. We had a very systematic interview as well as class observation system to select the teachers with right qualification and attitude. We now have one new teacher for playgroup, which is Mamata Basnet, one for L.K.G which is Bina Thokar and one for class 2, Sarita Balam.



We would like to congratulate and welcome them to our big family. From this session now, there are total 109 children studying in DMS and 8 Children get support in other schools and weaving dreams for their future.
